

FISHES OF THE LAKE EDWARD SYSTEM



Notes: The Lake Edward system is a watershed encompassing lakes Edward and George, and all the rivers, streams, and wetlands associated with the lakes. The illustrations used are from the Freshwater Biodiversity Portal for Uganda (freshwaterbiodiversity.go.ug), FishBase (fishbase.org), and publications by many scientists who work on fishes of Uganda. All *Haplochromis* not highlighted as introduced, and other species with a star on the scientific name are endemic in the system. Dummy pictures were used for species (e.g., *Haplochromis oregosoma*) where actual images were not available. The text in italics refers to scientific name. Common names, including local names if available, follow. **Possibly Extant** means absence of a record of the species in the last 30 years. **Vulnerable** means that the species is threatened on the national red list of the fishes of Uganda (freshwaterbiodiversity.go.ug/iucn_assessment). Nile perch in the system is only known in Lake Saka, a small crater lake.
